PASTOR SCOT'S PONDERINGS...

Meet Our (not so) New Bishop: Rev. Paul D. Erickson

Each year around the beginning of June the Greater Milwaukee Synod, of which Mount Olive is a part, holds its annual Synod Assembly. This year will be the one-year anniversary for Bishop Erickson as our bishop. In the past year, Bishop Erickson has spent a lot of time just listening to what the over 120 congregations of our synod are doing as we strive to serve Christ in the world. He also listened to the great pain of too many of these congregations who, for many reasons, have little hope in continuing.

God is doing great things in our synod, but there are dramatic changes happening in the church that Bishop Paul is trying to address. Some of these changes we understand. Others, we cannot yet even begin to imagine. All of which will bring some sort of death to many if not all congregations. This isn't doom and gloom, it is simply the fact that Christ is doing a new thing and it's both scary and wonderful at the same time.

Pray for Bishop Paul as he now moves forward in trying to understand how to meet these challenges. Pray for him and our synod staff as they minister to the pastors and congregations of our synod and help shepherd us through these unsettling times.

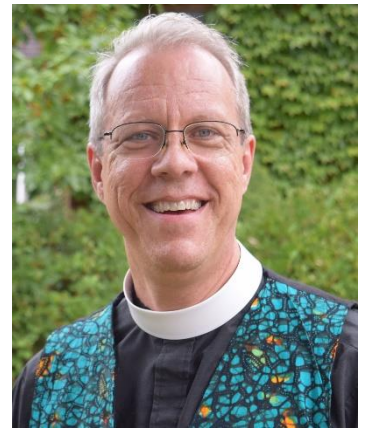

The Rev. Paul D. Erickson was elected June 4, 2016, to a six-year term as bishop of the Greater Milwaukee Synod of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America.



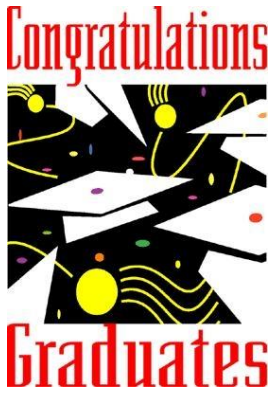
"I'm excited and hopeful about our future as we continue the work of establishing vibrant faith communities committed to working with God in the establishment of a more just, peaceful and compassionate world," Erickson said. *"The Greater Milwaukee Synod has a strong history of creative and faithful ministry, and I look forward to finding out what God has in store for us all as this next chapter unfolds."*

Erickson earned a Bachelor of Arts degree from Gustavus Adolphus and a Master of Divinity from the Lutheran School of Theology at Chicago. He holds a Doctor of Ministry degree in Congregational Mission and Leadership from Luther Seminary.

He returns to the Greater Milwaukee Synod from St. Paul, where he served as the director of Agora, a ministry that works to develop lay leaders for immigrant and multicultural congregations in Minnesota and South Dakota. Erickson served as a pastor in the Greater Milwaukee Synod from 1993-2003 at Faith/Santa Fe Lutheran Church in Milwaukee.

"I have a passion for God's church, God's people, and God's world, and I love exploring new places and finding new ways to connect with others," Erickson wrote in response to a question about the gifts he would bring as synod bishop. *"I love to sing, teach, preach, and laugh, and I try to use my gifts in a way that creates a space in which others can be their best selves."*

Paul and his wife, Lynn (also an ELCA pastor), have two children: David, 20, and Sarah, 16

WHAT: High School Youth Mission Trip

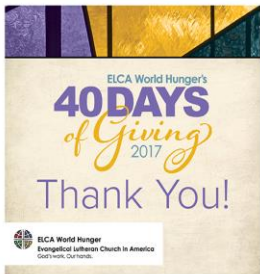
WHERE: Louisville, Kentucky, with the Youthworks organization
