COUNCIL CORNER

Greetings from your Council!

In the first six months of 2017, your ministry teams and Council have been working on a number of items outside of the usual day in, day out, faith community stuff.



A number of years ago, our Property Team reviewed our building and grounds and prepared a maintenance schedule for our physical plant. Your leadership team has worked together to keep up with these items, such as new boilers and interior and exterior painting. This year, the Property Team has received bids to paint the barn and replace the original carpeting in the building. At our June Council meeting, Property Team Chairperson Larry Redlin brought the team's recommendations to the Council, which then discussed and approved them.

As the proposal to carpet the building exceeds the \$10,000 limit on non-budgeted expenditures, Council has elected to call a special congregational meeting for **Sunday, July 16th, at 10:30 a.m.** Our Property and Finance Teams will be on hand to present their recommendation regarding the carpeting, and we as a congregation will vote on their recommendation. We will also hear updates regarding the work of our other ministry teams and task forces. Official notice is elsewhere in the newsletter. We hope that you will be able to attend this important meeting.

Looking forward to August, we are excited to invite all of you to grow deeper in your involvement at Mount Olive, whether it be with our ministry teams or by helping to lead Mount Olive into discipleship as followers of Christ.

- ★ On **Monday, August 7th, at 6 p.m.**, we will hold our Annual All Team Night planning evening. On this evening, we will plan for our ministries in 2017-18, while sharing our ideas with each other to better work together as a congregation. Join us at All Team Night for food and thought, as well as fun. This is a great time to deepen your involvement in our faith community.

- ★ On **Monday, August 14th, at 6 p.m.**, we will host a big picture discussion and meal open to the entire congregation. We will discuss the changing church and social culture in which Mount Olive exists today, and how this culture offers us exciting new opportunities to grow as disciples of Christ. We ask that those interested in participating prepare for the conversation through two readings and prayerful consideration. If you would like to be a part of this discussion, please RSVP to Pastor Scot or me by **Sunday, July 30th**.

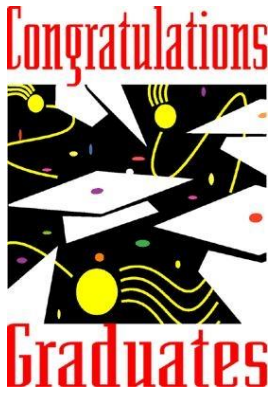
Also, as part of Mount Olive's call to our ordained leadership, we are grateful to offer the opportunity for a sabbatical leave following six years of call to our congregation. As Pastor Scot was officially called to Mount Olive in 2012, he will be eligible for a sabbatical leave in 2018. And in order for the sabbatical to be as positive for the congregation as it will be for Pastor, preparation is key. We are in the process of forming a Sabbatical Planning Team. Might you want to be a part of this team, or are you interested in learning how you might use your gifts for ministry during this time? Please contact me or any council member.

And you might ask, just what is a sabbatical? A sabbatical leave is granted to provide an opportunity for the minister to take an extended period of time (at MTO, three months) for renewal, enrichment, study, spiritual growth, travel, skill development, research, and/or experimentation. Experience has shown that the congregation and its ministries directly benefit from such study, growth, and renewal. Long-term ministry is revitalized and stimulated, as is the minister.

WHERE: Louisville, Kentucky, with the Youthworks organization

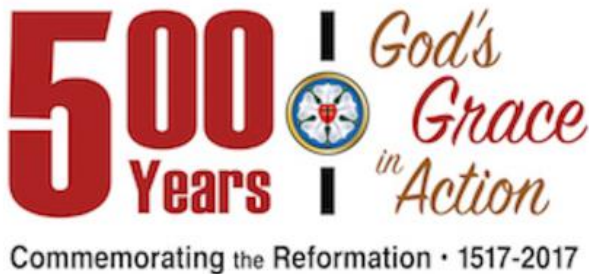
WHEN: July 23-28, 2017
