PASTOR SCOT'S PONDERINGS...

There is no one in this world who is not looking for God. Everyone is trudging along with as much dignity, courage, and style as they possibly can. ~Hafiz

Iron sharpens iron,
and one person sharpens the wits of another.
~ Proverbs 27

Growing as disciples of Christ is not about New Year's Resolutions. It is not about "trying harder" this year either. It is about consistency, learning and growing. Trudging along is a fitting metaphor for discipleship. It's pushing on even when everything in you screams, "STOP. That's good enough." We get tired and bored because nothing seems to change. Our prayers are cold. We don't see God working anything new in our lives and so we can become just okay with our faith. We're not satisfied, of course, but it's good enough.

So how do we find the strength to trudge along? Pushing against our own wants toward that which we need? One way we find the strength to take just one more step is in a community of faith. That place where we can be vulnerable because everyone there is trudging right along with us. It is in that community of faith where we find encouragement and visions of hope. And sometimes it is the place where we get hauled along until we find the strength to stand and continue on our own.

Just as being able to continue the journey takes intentionality, so does finding that community of others that will walk along with us. It's important to be with a small group that has the same desires to challenge, encourage, and support each other in their faith. These little communities have to be intentional about their purpose.

I think it is very important that we seek out others with whom we want to trudge along. Over this next year my desire is to offer some ways to help equip you to form such a community or transform the community you are already in to be more intentional.

But until this plan takes some shape, may God bless you with a community, or at least, a fellow traveler who will help you take next step.

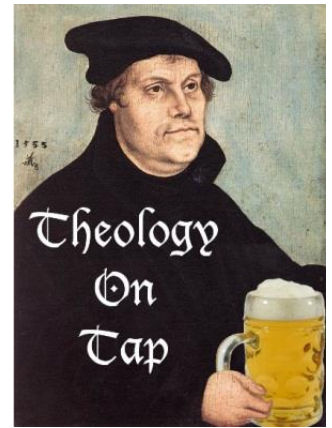
