The kingdom of God: What does it mean for God to be in charge? by the Rev. Mark Allan Powell

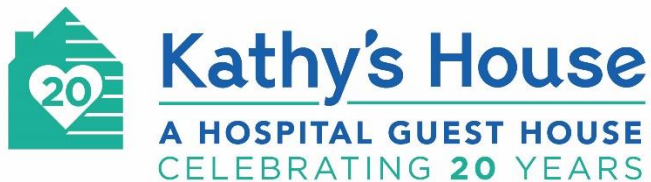
New Testament scholar Mark Allan Powell looks at a widely used biblical image and invites us into a discussion of what it might mean for Lutheran women today. The phrase "kingdom of God" and similar expressions turn up repeatedly in sayings of Jesus, so understanding what that expression means helps us to make sense of numerous parables and popular Bible passages (including the Lord's Prayer). There may be some surprises: the phrase refers to an activity, not a location—and it has nothing to do with God being a "king," at least so far as that image suggests a (usually male) tyrant who gives orders and dominates the lives of his subjects. Powell is author of the world's best-selling New Testament textbook and editor of the *Harper-Collins Bible Dictionary*.

In February the topic is Mysteries of the kingdom: Parables, banquets and children – and this month we will consider "kingdom parables" and ask how the kingdom of God is like a net or a treasure or a pearl or whatever. We will also look at an "acted parable" in which Jesus dramatizes the "kingdom" as a banquet where honored guests include misfits and outcasts. And *then* we will discover (or recall) who we should regard as the greatest in the kingdom and the most important members of any church.

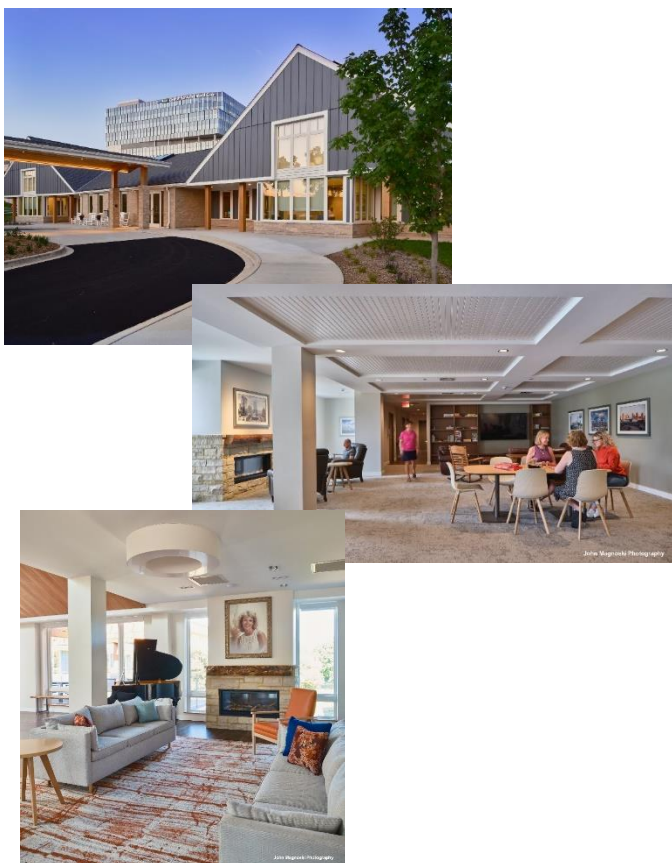
MOUNT OLIVE ACTS TEAM UPDATE

The Mount Olive ACTS team recently disbursed gifts to help grow God's ministry to several partners. Each month we will highlight a recipient in order to bring awareness to how the memorial from Dorothy Gollmar's estate is being used to spread God's love.



Update from ACTS Partner, Kathy's House

Kathy's House is a Hospital Guest House that provides lodging and a supportive environment to families who are experiencing one of life's most stressful situations—personal illness or the serious illness of a loved one. Their new Home, better outfitted for patients they serve, opened in June 2021. Their mission is a commitment to providing affordable lodging and caring support in a “home away from home” environment for patients and families who need to travel to Milwaukee to access medical care. In surveys, 40% of patient guests reported they would not have been able to access needed medical care in Milwaukee without a facility such as Kathy's House.



SERVICE TEAM

Thank you all for your donation of eye glasses for the Lions Club recycle eyeglasses program. Your donation makes it possible for many needy individuals to receive life changing sight improvement. The program does the following:



1. The glasses are shipped to the nearest Lions Eyeglass Recycling Center where trained volunteers sort, clean and determine the prescription strengths of the glasses.
2. Volunteers at the recycling center carefully package the prepared glasses and store them until they are required for eyeglass dispensing missions. Glasses that are not suitable for reuse are recycled for scrap, with the earnings benefitting local Lions projects.
3. At the mission site, eye care professionals and trained Lion volunteers perform vision screenings and dispense the appropriate recycled glasses, free of charge, to children and adults in need.

February Focus

In February we will be collecting items for the Ft. McCoy Sewing Center. The following items are needed:

- **2.5 yard** and larger pieces of fabric of different solid colors, patterns, and weights that can be used for dresses and larger projects
- Interfacing material for inside of garments
- Crotchet hooks, knitting needles and yarn (**50 grams** and larger skeins please)

Items can be dropped off at the church during the month of February.
