## **DEVOTIONS**

Think about devotions as a continuation of our community's worship. The following basic pattern could be one way of forming your household's devotions. Adapt as necessary!

## GATHERING

✤ Light a candle to help you focus this time as "God time."

#### ✤ Prayer of the Week

God, we sing to you songs of praise, knowing that we have been freed from the troubles of this world. Your Son, Jesus Christ has liberated our minds and removed the shackles from our hearts so that we are able to share your love with everyone. Amen.

## **CARING CONVERSATION**

Take a moment to check in with each other or to use the questions below.

- Thinking about This Week's Story: Paul and Silas are imprisoned for spreading the good news. While there, they sing their way through an earthquake. The jailer, who scared for his life, learns about the love of Jesus from Paul. When was a time today that you were afraid? What did you do?
- Getting Ready for Next Week's Story: Paul travels to the city of Athens and speaks with the people there. Many disagree with him. When you have you agreed with someone today? When have you disagreed?

## DAILY BIBLE READING

Read aloud from the DAILY BIBLE READING from the front. What do you want to remember from this reading?

## PRAY TOGETHER

Sit or stand in a circle, and pray for those who are imprisoned that they might find liberty and freedom in Jesus Christ.

## **CLOSING**

✤ If you used a candle, extinguish it as a sign of the end of the devotion time.
