GATHERING

✤ Light a candle to help you focus this time as "God time."

✤ <u>Prayer of the Week</u>

God, you are the One who makes all things new! Let us rejoice and be glad in it! Amen!

CARING CONVERSATION

Take a moment to check in with each other or to use the questions below.

- Thinking about This Week's Story: Paul writes near the end of his letter to the Philippians to pray in confidence to God and not worry. What is one thing that has worried you today? What is something that has made you rejoice?

DAILY BIBLE READING

Read aloud from the DAILY BIBLE READING from the front. What do you want to remember from this reading?

PRAY TOGETHER

✤ Ask each person to say or write down at least one thing that is worrying them. Lift the worries up and pray: God of peace, we bring these worries to you. Thank you for the many blessings you have given us. Help us to rejoice in you. Amen.

<u>CLOSING</u>

earrow If you used a candle, extinguish it as a sign of the end of the devotion time.
