

MOUNT OLIVE ACTS TEAM UPDATE

The Mount Olive ACTS team recently disbursed gifts to help grow God's ministry to several partners. Each month we will highlight a recipient in order to bring awareness to how the memorial from Dorothy Gollmar's estate is being used to spread God's love.



Who is Breaking the Chains Church:

The Greater Milwaukee Synod (GMS) of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America (ELCA) has worked closely with Prison Congregations of America to develop a Lutheran congregation inside the Wisconsin Department of Corrections (DOC) facility. This ministry is known as Breaking the Chains Church (BtCC).

Under the current pastoral leadership of Rev. David Rebey, Breaking the Chains Church is worshipping regularly with an average of seven or eight residents and eight to ten Greater Milwaukee Synod congregation members at every worship. Thanks to virtual meetings, Breaking the Chains has been able to maintain weekly worship at a relatively high level of interaction and a sense of community.

How Does Breaking the Chains Church Help?

Prison gives one a lot of time to read, to ponder and to pray. During a conversation about how God calls each one of us, based on the Matthew 5 text of Jesus calling the first disciples, several men wondered aloud if they are heeding God's call at this time in their lives. It is obvious from the Biblical narrative that God chooses people of all types of backgrounds, from pious Gentiles to rebellious Israelites, to everyday, working-class people. The men inside the Felmers Chaney Correctional Center in Kenosha have made big mistakes in their lives, sometimes catastrophic. For many, this leads them to now want to follow what God would have them do. Worrying about all of this led to one man sharing this statement, "I do not want to be disqualified from God's love." Breaking the Chains Church is providing a place for the love and grace of God to be reaffirmed in the lives of believers who are desperately seeking Jesus, Praise be to God for this ministry of the Greater Milwaukee Synod of the Evangelical Lutheran Church of America.


What Can MTO do to Help?

Breaking the Chains group welcomes volunteers in some aspects of the ministry such as attendance and participation in weekly worship and mid-week bible class. Volunteers are required to take the Dept. of Corrections training before they are permitted to participate in activities inside a correction institution. There are other activities outside the institution such as nurturing congregations to see prison ministry as part of their congregational ministry.


