MOUNT OLIVE ACTS TEAM UPDATE

The Mount Olive ACTS team recently disbursed gifts to help grow God's ministry to several partners. Each month we will highlight a recipient in order to bring awareness to how the memorial from Dorothy Gollmar's estate is being used to spread God's love.



Who is Safe Babies Healthy Families: A program of Easterseals Southeast Wisconsin, is designed to assist parents with challenges like single parenthood, low income, history of abuse or adverse childhood experiences, substance misuse, mental health, or domestic violence. Services begin prenatally or within three months of birth, and services can continue until the child's fifth birthday. The staff works to provide resources and referrals to the families they serve and help clients meet their goals, be independent, and provide a safe, stable, and nurturing home for their children. **This year**, Mt. Olive is supporting their initiative with birthday bags for the families, both the parent and child. These bags would include items such as birthday cake mix, frosting, candles, plates, napkins and then a small gift. The sample plan is for the child's first birthday to do a shape sorter or large blocks, for the second birthday a doll or truck, third birthday a Kohls cares book and stuffed animal, and for 4 and 5-year-old birthdays a learning game such as memory, chutes, and ladders or candy land. For the primary caregiver, most often mom, they would offer a small body wash and lotion, \$10 Starbucks gift card or a plant. If the primary caregiver is dad a \$10 fast food gift card, a utility tool, or Amazon or video play card.

How Safe Babies Healthy Families help: There are two main missions: to assist children to be school-ready, which is done by providing activities and developmental screenings on a weekly or bi-weekly basis, and second, to prevent child abuse and neglect. The majority of the families have experienced trauma in their lives and may be struggling financially, with mental health, drugs, and alcohol, domestic violence, etc. The organization helps build them up by providing support, education, and resources for their families.

How can MTO help? Safe Babies Healthy Families uses volunteers to help organize their *Earn as you Learn Store*. They look for volunteers to help provide childcare for groups or make a meal for groups. They're looking for people to spread the word or conduct clothing drives for **children's clothes under size 5T, both new and gently used**. A gift card drive would be helpful to fill other needs, such as groceries, gas, or basic supplies for the child and family. With no marketing budget, Safe Babies Healthy Families relies on referral sources in hospitals, community, and state agencies. Any social media mentions, links to their website, or newsletter profiles are welcomed and appreciated.

Jesus and nature: Teachers of Faith by the Rev. Sara Olson-Smith

Jesus often turned to the natural world in teaching, opening our eyes to see creation not just as something to be cared for, but as our teacher and kindred. It is no mistake that Jesus, who lovingly spoke of soil and plants, was thought to be a gardener that first Easter morning. This three-session Bible study will shift our perspectives and allow nature to be our teacher, through the words of Jesus and other parts of Scripture. The trees, the soil and the creatures will offer us new perspectives on the character of God and challenge us to deepen our stewardship of God's precious creation.

October 2022, Session 2: "Soil," will dig deeply into the parable of the soil (otherwise known as the parable of the seed, Matthew 13) and other Biblical accounts that relate to care for this part of creation, while looking at models of growth that involve wholeness and wellness.

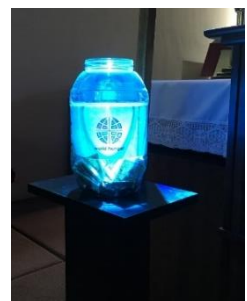
