SERVICE TEAM UPDATE

April/May Service Team Project – **Blessing Bags**

During the months of April and May the Service Team will be collecting items to make "Blessing Bags" to be donated to The Community Space (TCS) in Whitewater, WI. TCS is a nonprofit organization run volunteers serving 270+ families per week providing food items, household

goods, clothing, etc. at no charge to the recipients. More information is available on their website communityspacewhitewater.com or on their Facebook page (search "The Community Space"). Donations are always welcome.

The "Blessing Bags" contain basic hygiene items and are gathered in a gallon plastic storage bag along with an encouraging note or blessing. These are quick giveaways for individuals in need. We are asking for donations of **Travel Size** hygiene items to fill the bags. These include:

Toothbrush, Toothpaste, Dental Floss, Bar Soap, Shampoo, Conditioner, Brush or Comb, Pocket Tissues, Chapstick or Lip Balm, Lotion or Sunscreen, Deodorant, Disposable Razors (2/pkg)

Items may be dropped off in the bin in the Narthex. You may donate individual items or make up the Blessing Bags on your own and include a written note or blessing.



Sleep in Heavenly Peace

Bob Dickey recently presented information about a volunteer organization called Sleep in Heavenly Peace, which builds and delivers beds to children in need. They are a volunteer staffed organization working at the county level across the U.S. SHP exists solely with community support including cash, tool and material donations, and hands-on volunteers for the build and delivery of the beds.

Close to Mt. Olive are SHP groups in both Waukesha and Walworth counties. Waukesha is well established and growing significantly, having delivered close to 200 beds in 2023. Walworth is in the early stages of development and looking at significant bed requests to be fulfilled. Both need support of all kinds. Bob has agreed to serve as communicator/coordinator within Mt. Olive for members who are looking to potentially get involved in whatever way with one or both groups. CALL COMMITTEE PROCESS AND STATUS REPORT

The Call Committee continues its efforts to find the right next Pastor for our congregation. We are working with the Synod to locate potential candidates to interview. We truly appreciate your prayers; they are making a difference. We are filled with hope as we wait to see where the Holy Spirit is leading us! We need your help, so please continue to pray for us!

Holy God, the One who Creates, Redeem and Sanctifies, we give You thanks and praise that by Your grace You have guided Your people here at Mt. Olive throughout our pastoral vacancy. Please Send Your spirit of discernment to potential candidates, that they may know whether You are leading them to be our next pastor. Please send that same spirit of discernment to the Call Committee, to know which candidates not only proclaim the Gospel in all that they do, but to see which candidates acknowledge that they are guided by Your Holy Spirit in making that proclamation. Help us to pray, "Thy will be done," and give us the confidence to trust that that will happen. In Your Holy Name we pray. Amen.

As a reminder, the Call process is outlined in the newsletter and posted on a bulletin board. If you have questions, please feel free to talk to one of the Call Committee members: Kiana Adcock, Betty Arntson, Nicole Carpenter, Bruce Gunderson, Dennis Martin, Eva Schindhelm and Tim Sperstad.

Please read the information below re-printed from previous newsletters if you are interested in all the details of the Call Committee. Also please feel free to reach out to Call Committee Team members if you have any questions or concerns. We need and truly appreciate everyone's continued prayers.

The Call Committee has met with our synod mentor for orientation and guidance on the process to be followed. In addition, the Call Committee meets weekly, with tasks assigned each week, to keep the process moving forward.

A very high-level outline of the process as follows:

PREPARATION:

- Detail review of the Ministry Site Profile.
- Preparation for initial interviews, including development of initial interview questions.

- Participation in a mock interview with a local clergy to "field test" the interview questions and process.
- Synod provides candidates' names and profiles for review.

CONSIDERING CANDIDATES:

- Conduct initial interviews (often via teleconference).
- Assessment of candidates and determination of those to be invited for a second interview.

SECOND INTERVIEWS:

- Preparation of second interview questions, tailored from results of initial interview and the candidate's profile.
- Conduct second Interviews. These are held locally and in person and may include a tour of the church and the local area.

FINAL CANDIDATE:

- Determination of a candidate to recommend to council and the congregation.
 Recommendations must be unanimous within the Call Committee.
- Notify Synod representative of preferred candidate.
- Synod verifies if the chosen candidate is interested in a call to Mount Olive.
- Check references, background check.
- Present recommendation to council.
- Special congregation meeting to propose candidate.

The above is a high-level outline intended to provide you with a general idea of the process. There are multiple tasks within each of the steps above. After the congregational meeting, the Council will then prepare an offer for the final candidate.

One significant component of the process is confidentiality. Most pastoral candidates are currently employed, so the Call Committee is required to maintain confidentiality of candidate information until the interview process is complete, the synod has been notified, and the candidate has confirmed interest in the call to Mount Olive.


