Growing up my brothers and I always knew we had good parents. Mom was very sweet yet the disciplinarian. Dad was easy going and active in the community. My brothers still teased me that I was the spoiled child. I really wasn't spoiled, but they now admit they were jealous because I had my own bedroom and the four of them had to share a bedroom. I never thought I was spoiled but always knew I was Daddy's little girl. Dad taught us the rules of camping, fishing, and running a business. We lovingly gave him the nickname, "The King." One time a friend said to me, "You have Ozzie and Harriet for parents," but back then I thought everybody did. I tried to be a good kid and never wanted to disappoint my dad.

When I was a freshman in high school an incident happened in East Troy that opened everyone's eyes to what family violence was and what it could result in. Then I really knew how blessed I was that God gave me the perfect parents to raise me.

After graduating from college and working down south, I decided I was moving on in life with what I wanted to do. I told my parents my plans, and they were both very upset. As I was leaving their house, my mom was yelling at me, and my dad was sitting in his recliner with his head in his hands sobbing. I felt terrible that I had hurt them both so badly. By the grace of God within six months all was good again. My parents had forgiven me, and our relationship was restored.

Ten years later I was living in Dallas, married with two children. One Sunday our pastor's sermon was on God's love for us. He said our Heavenly Father loves us even when we do things to disappoint Him. Later that afternoon it hit me...if I hurt my earthly father that much that he was sobbing, think how much I hurt my Heavenly Father! I was overwhelmed by the goodness and forgiveness in God's love. Many years have passed now, but I thank God everyday for His perfect Fatherly love of an imperfect child.

About the summer study: A global pandemic, political upheaval, a changing climate... these days, the future is more uncertain than it has ever been. Or is it? For the people of the Bible, life was often shaped by deep uncertainty. Encounters with God sparked awe, confusion or courage, but rarely certainty. Instead, God's people have always been called to follow God into the unknown, trusting in God's certain grace and love. This three-session summer Bible study explores God's invitation to the people of the Bible and to us, to take the holy journey beyond certainty to curiosity, community and compassion, where we find abundant life in Christ.

*After certainty: Curiosity* Jesus' ministry, during the uncertainty of the first century Roman occupation, often challenged the "certainties" of the status quo when it came to faith, power and relationships—both the relationships between people and God, and between people in community.
