A PERSONAL JOURNEY OF FAITH

When I was young, Saturday morning catechism was a regular thing for my older brother and I. I remember my second-grade nun, Sister Mary

Bernadette. She was very young and beautiful and told us many Bible stories about Jesus in preparation for our first Holy Communion. At the end of our lesson time, all classes would gather together to sing and clap while Sister Anella played a fiddle. Saturday morning catechism continued through eighth grade then came Monday evening CCD classes. My relationship with God continued to grow and become a driving force in my life. Through it all, I learned wonderful stories from the nuns and lay teachers, but they <u>never</u> picked up a Bible to read to us.

When I got married and joined the Lutheran Church, I realized I really knew nothing about the Bible. When our daughter was in third grade she received a Bible in Sunday School. That is still the Bible I use today.

I had often thought of joining a Bible study class but didn't want anyone to see my ignorance of the Bible and question my faith. Then at Mount Olive a friendly outgoing person invited me to Sunday morning Bible study; that person was Laura Conry. I had previously seen the class going on in the library but I thought "Oh no, if I go to class, would I have to speak or worse yet look up a verse and read from the Bible!"

Finally, one Sunday I decided to sit in on the class and learned that I had nothing to be afraid of, nothing to feel self-conscious about. Everyone was very welcoming, and I could sit, listen, and learn. And learn I have. It seems we all learn as we read and discuss the chapters each week. We plan the studies from September through May, and everyone attends as they are able. We've studied Paul's journeys and his letters. We watched videos of Kenneth Bailey explaining Jewish life and customs under Roman rule during Jesus' life on earth. Last May, we ended a two-year study of Genesis...a book filled with sibling rivalry, murder, jealousy, forgiveness and God's everlasting love and promises kept." I am looking forward to our classes starting again on September 15th at 9 a.m. We will be discussing the chapters of 1 Kings. Please consider this as my personal invitation to join us on any Sunday as you are able.



THE KNOTTY KNITTERS...


