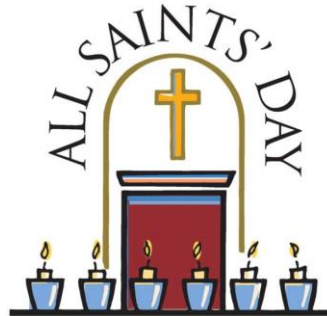

A MESSAGE FROM PASTOR STEVE

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ:

Walking with you as your pastor has been a tremendous gift and pleasure. My first month has been a great start to getting to know the people of Mount Olive, but I continue to look forward to a day when I fully know the congregation and its wonderful spirit.

One of the great pleasures of being a pastor is walking with people of faith during the holidays. I am excited to write that we are about to enter into a season of celebration very soon, through Thanksgiving.

The holiday we know as Thanksgiving began as a day of giving thanks for the blessing of the fall harvest. As faithful people, we are entering that time of year when we are reminded to give thanks for the blessing of the harvest of eternal life through the birth of Jesus Christ.

May God’s generous peace be with you, always!

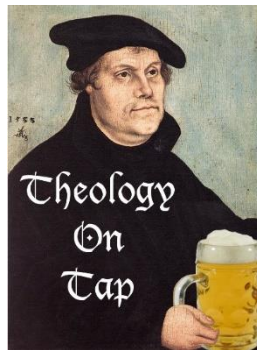

THE KNOTTY KNITTERS...

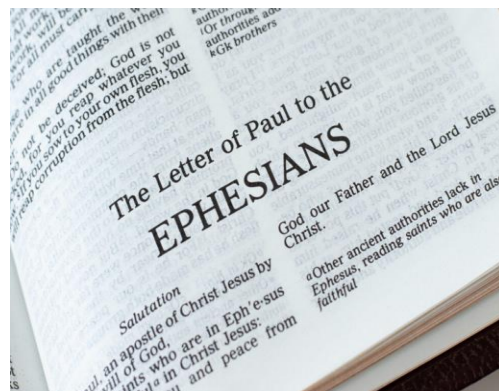

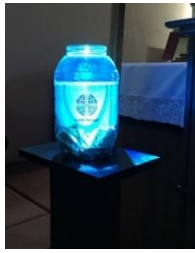
