A MESSAGE FROM PASTOR STEVE

Pleasant words are like a honeycomb, sweetness to the soul and health to the body. Proverbs 16:24

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ:

He is risen; He is risen, indeed, alleluia! The phrase "He is risen" feels fantastic to write, but it is better to say it loudly and proudly with others' voices in response. This is a precious time of year. He is risen! He is risen, indeed! Alleluia, Easter has come. God has saved us from the time of trial. Through faith, we are forgiven and given our life back to us by the grace of God through Jesus Christ. We can know that Jesus has done everything possible to bring us back into a relationship with our Creator that is life-giving.

God blesses us with a wonderful story to share with others. This month, I was given an article to share. I thought a newsletter article would be the best way to share this information. For this month, I will rely on a devotional from *Closer to God Each Day Devotional*. This devotional is based on Proverbs 16:24. I hope you enjoy its message about love.

An essential part of learning to love others is learning to love them with our words. The strength and encouragement we share with our words make a difference! People everywhere need someone to believe in them. They have been wounded by the wrong words, but the right words can bring healing in their lives.

It is easy to point out flaws, weaknesses, and failures in those around us. Judgment can be a natural reaction that comes from our flesh. However, these words do not bring life; they can only magnify what we think is wrong with people and their situations. Yet, the Bible says in Romans 12:21 that we are to overcome evil with good.

The closer we get to God, the more we will learn to speak positive, encouraging words about life. God is positive, and as we walk with Him, we will learn to agree with Him (Amos 3:3).

It is easy to find something wrong with everyone, but love overlooks the faults of others. First Peter 4:8 says, "Above all things have intense and unfailing love for one another, for love covers a multitude of sins [forgives and disregards the offenses of others]."

Believing the best about people and speaking words that build them up is essential to loving them.

Blessings to you this Easter season, as we are resurrection people.

How

A check may be written to Mount Olive, designated to "Lenten Goats" and placed in an offering envelope. You can also use the MTO donation link, designating your donation "Lenten Goats". The goats cost \$50 each and when we work together, gifts of all shapes and sizes come together for increased purchasing power! Let's see how many goats we can donate as a congregation!

Why goats? Goats can go where other animals can't, surviving in some of the world's most challenging terrain and unreliable climates. Fresh milk from a goat provides daily nutrition for children and their families. What's more, goats are incredibly quick to reproduce, and they provide an opportunity for families to pass the gift on to others.

As a Lenten practice, you might set a daily Lenten donation goal for the 40 days of Lent, or possibly match an amount spent on a family outing/meal out, or forgo an ice cream treat, donating that amount that would have been spent on the treat in your "Screaming Goat" fund.





Free Pantry/ Kitchen Kupboard Food Pantry






