Dear friends,

He is risen! He is risen indeed! Alleluia!

Easter has arrived, and with it comes the most beautiful news we will ever hear. Through Jesus' life, death, and resurrection, we are welcomed back into a living, life-giving relationship with God. Because of His love poured out for us, and through faith; which itself is God's gracious gift, we are forgiven. We are made new. We are given a holy life that will never end.

Jesus has done everything needed to bring us home. Nothing needs to be added. Nothing needs to be earned. It is finished. It is grace upon grace.

God's love is not just an idea we talk about; it is something God has done, and continues to do. The Holy Spirit gently calls us to faith and draws us into this new life. 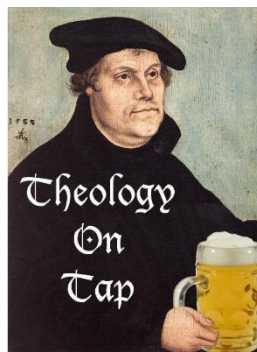
I am deeply grateful for this community of faith and for the kindness, support, and encouragement you have

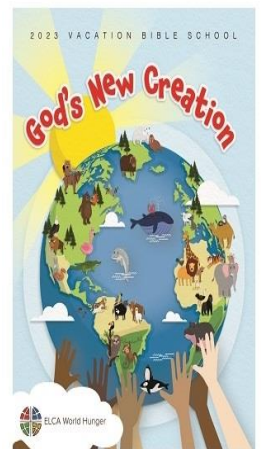

WEDNESDAY NIGHT & SUNDAY MORNING BIBLE STUDY

Wednesday Night Bible study meets at 6:30 p.m. on Wednesdays in the Fellowship Hall. Our first topic will be the completion of the study we began last year of the New Testament book of Romans, under the expert teaching leadership of Richard Grosenick. When that is completed, Richard will lead us in a study of the New Testament Book of Acts. That book's complete name is The Acts of the Apostles, and it is the account of the ministries of Peter and Paul in spreading the gospel. Acts was written by Luke as a continuation of his Gospel message. Richard cannot be with us in January, so we will then do a 5-week study of the short New Testament book of James, led by various members of the class who have already volunteered.

The Wednesday night class welcomes people with all levels of Biblical knowledge. You need not be a Bible "expert." Furthermore, 25% of the class are members of congregations other than Mount Olive, so feel free to invite your friends and neighbors to attend with you. For more information contact Dwight Cruikshank.

The Sunday adult education group meets from 9–9:50 a.m., between the worship services. This next educational year, we will be meeting in the Fellowship Hall (except when other activities are scheduled for that space) so that we can accommodate more people and so we can more easily have snacks or beverages.

The main topic for this coming year's study will be the New Testament book of Matthew. Matthew's focus is the fulfillment of the Old Testament prophecies through Jesus – to prove that Jesus is the Messiah. We won't get through the entire book this year, but join us as we discover, or re-discover, the Gospel of Matthew – the birth and early years of Jesus, the beginnings of his ministry, and his journeys with the disciples.

In addition to Matthew, we will also be doing some short studies during Advent and Lent. This year we will explore the Miracles and Heroes of the Bible. They both promise to be intriguing subjects, so don't miss out!

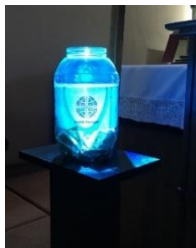
Session two—Gate and shepherd: Guiding and protecting us (John 10)
